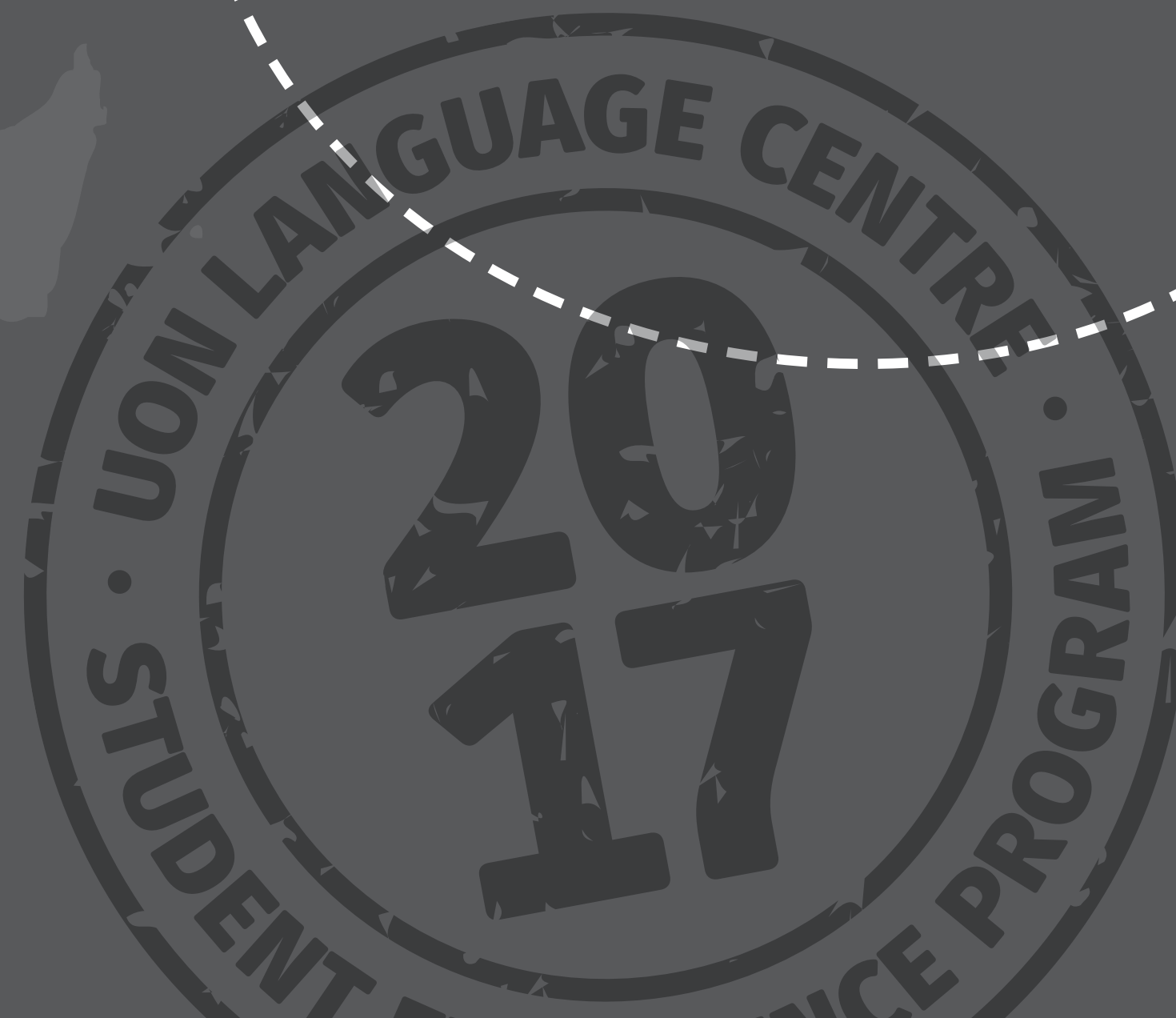

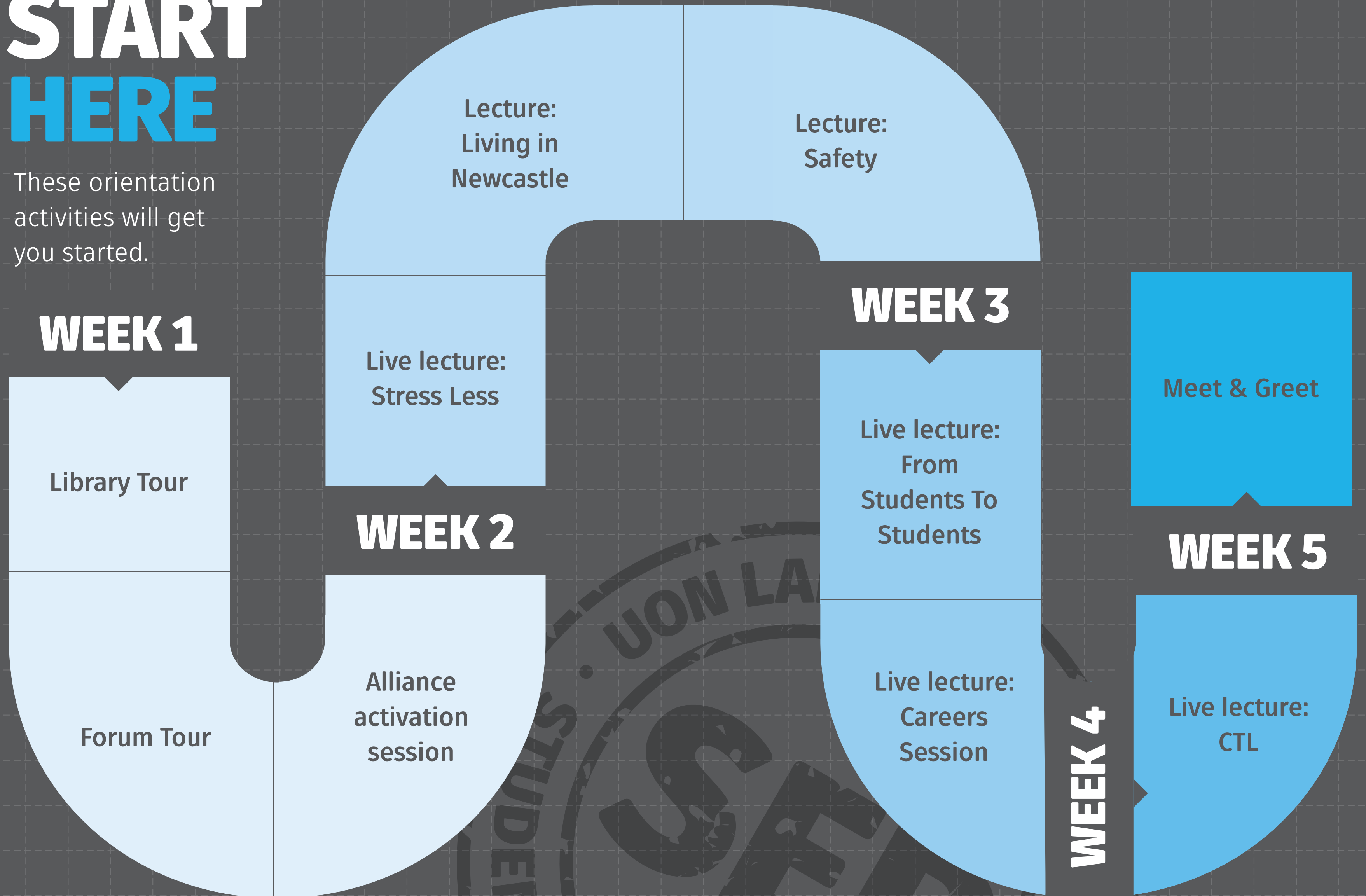
It takes longer than one day to settle in to a new country and learning environment.
