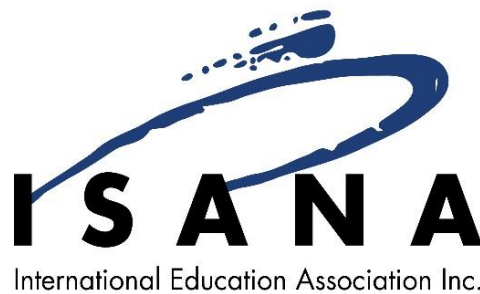

April and May have been very busy months for ISANA with lots of activity at the Federal level in international education.

Danielle Hartridge and I represented ISANA at the public hearings of the parliamentary inquiry into **Australia's tourism and international education sectors**. The discussion and ideas being considered by the parliamentary committee promise a broad report that will address the issues and challenges currently facing the sector.

ISANA's submission was compiled in December using input from ISANA Members at a consultation session we hosted late last year. In addition to that submission, we also provided submissions to two migration inquiries. These are publicly available here <https://isana.org.au/home/submissions/>

Largely, we utilised information provided by ISANA Members at the consultation session. It's vital we hear from Members about challenges and issues, ideas and new solutions to enable accurate representation and advocacy at these national forums.

Thank you to those who contributed and assisted with drafting the submissions. A huge thanks to Danielle for her support at both hearings.

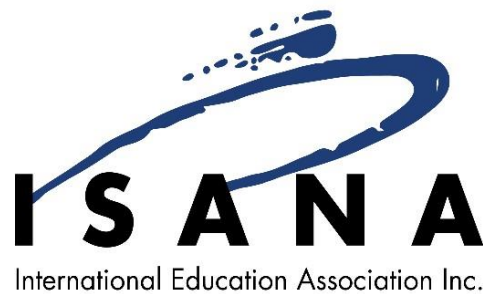

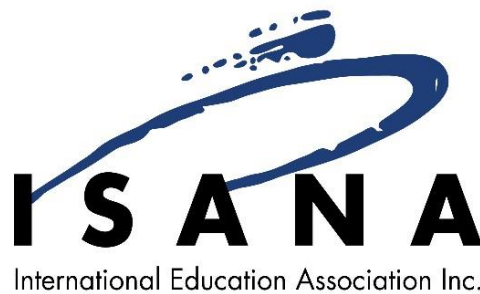

The National Code Tutorial (NCT)

The NCT is an online training course designed to teach the Education Services for Overseas



International Education Association Inc.

Students (ESOS) Act 2000 (ESOS Act) and National Code of Practice for Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students (National Code 2018) to professionals in the international education sector. It is intended for ongoing use to all registered participants.

The ESOS Act establishes legislative requirements and standards for the quality assurance of education and training institutions offering courses to international students who are in Australia on a student visa. ESOS also provides tuition fee protection for international students. Australia provides rigorous protection for international students through the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 (ESOS Act) and related legislation, which protects and enhances Australia's reputation for quality education, provides tuition protection and supports the integrity of the student visa program.

The National Code is a legislative instrument made under the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 and sets nationally consistent standards to support providers to deliver quality education and training to overseas students. Education institutions must comply with the National Code to maintain their registration to provide education services to international students. The Australian Government released the revised National Code of Practice for Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2018 which commenced on 1 January 2018. The National Code 2018 supports the National Strategy for International Education 2025 to advance Australia as a global leader in education, training and research. Education providers must comply with the National Code to maintain their registration to provide education services to overseas students.

ISANA Membership Renewal

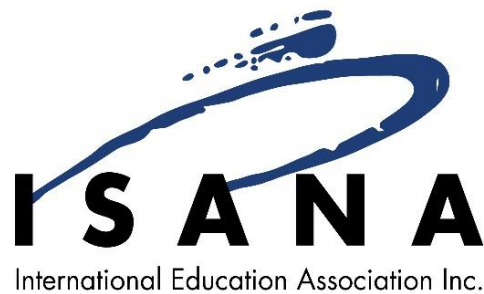
Membership renewals will be issued next week and due by July 1. We do allow twelve weeks, from the date of issue, for payment to be received.
