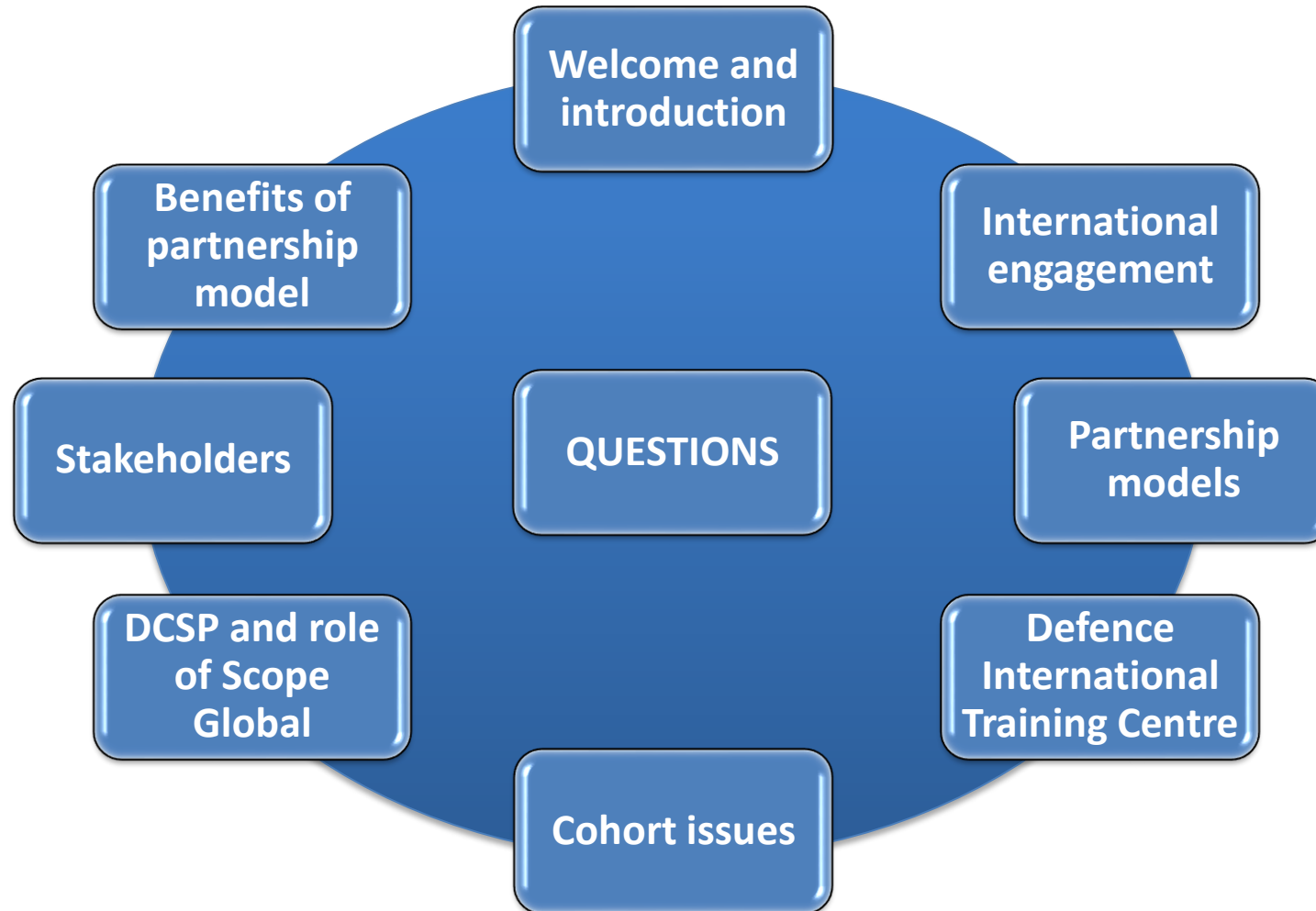

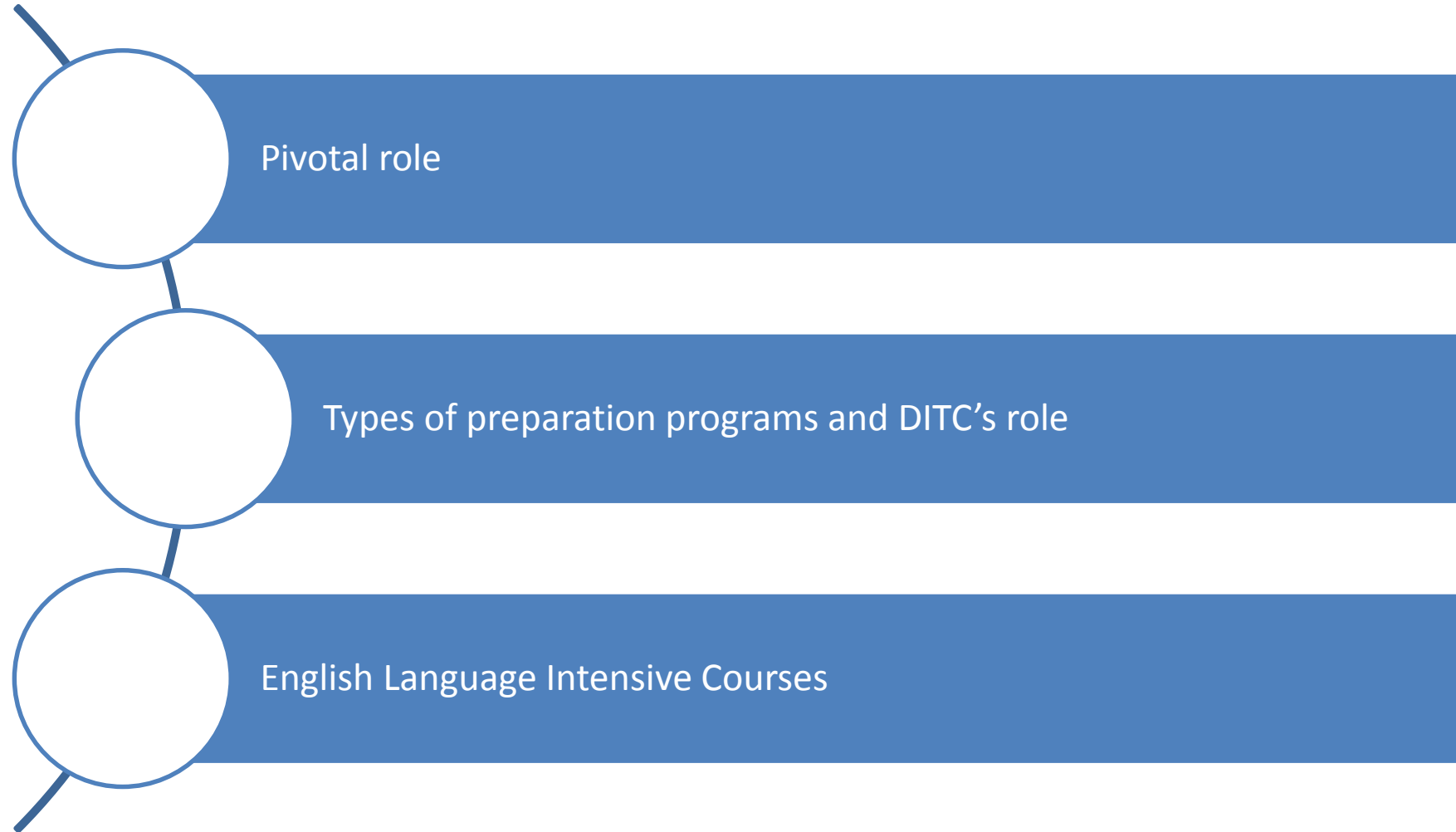

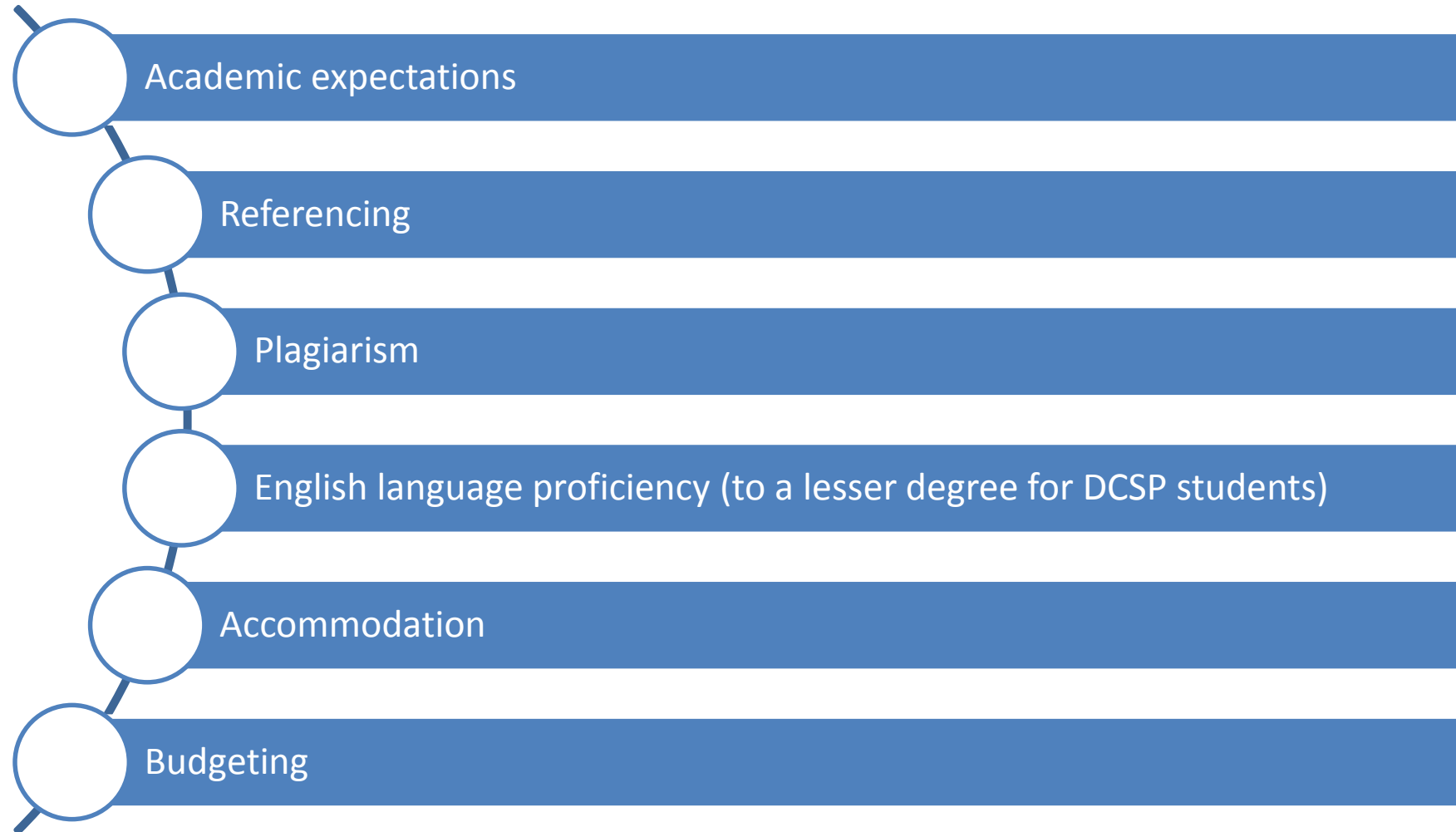

Unique features of Defence students

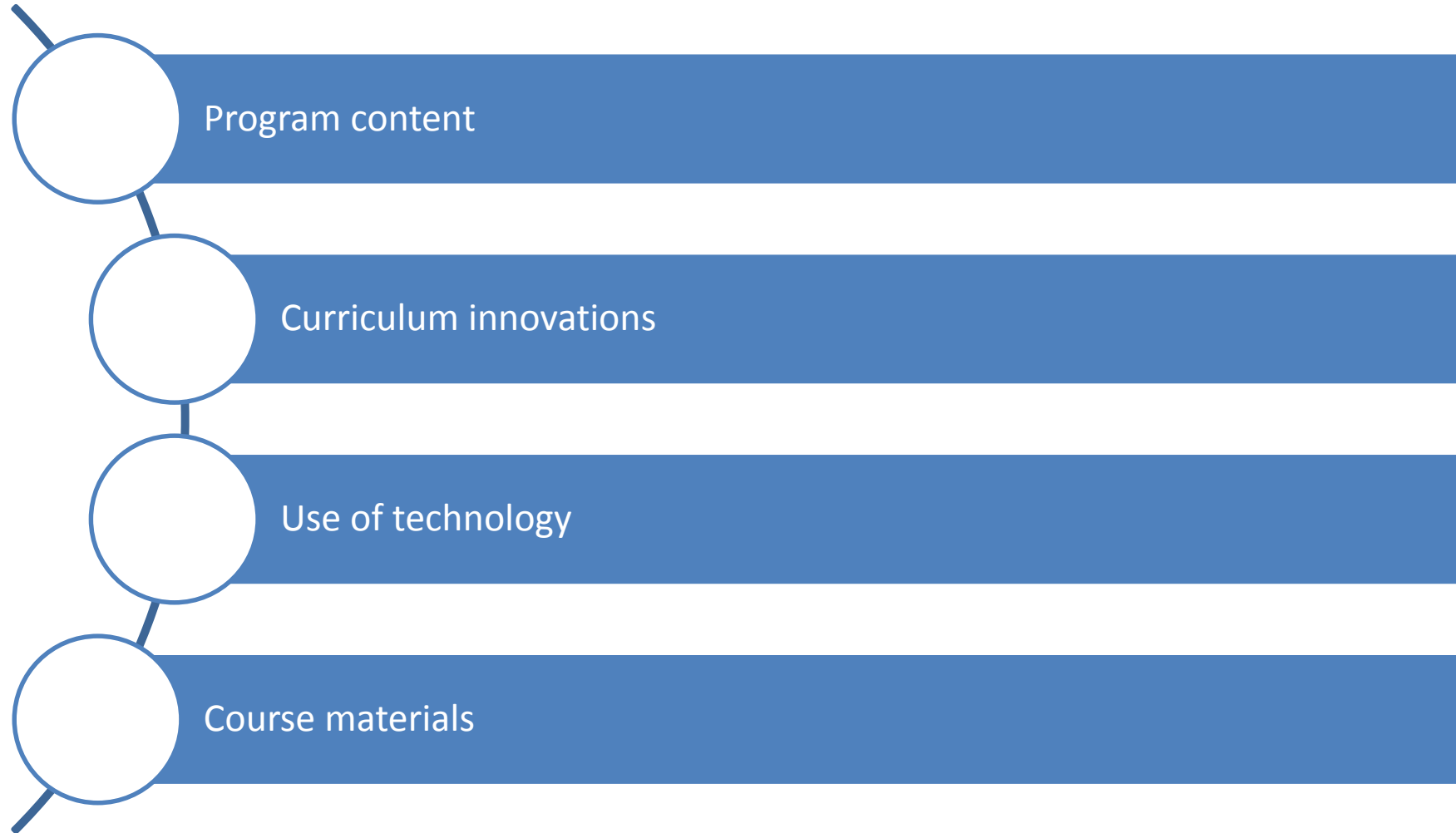
- Discipline and motivation
- Opportunity, aptitude and ambition
- Sponsorship of families (visas, travel, OSHC)
- Not permitted to work while sponsored by Defence
- Ongoing support for each cohort
- Identity as a cohort (regardless of target program)
- No possibility for migration – return of service obligations



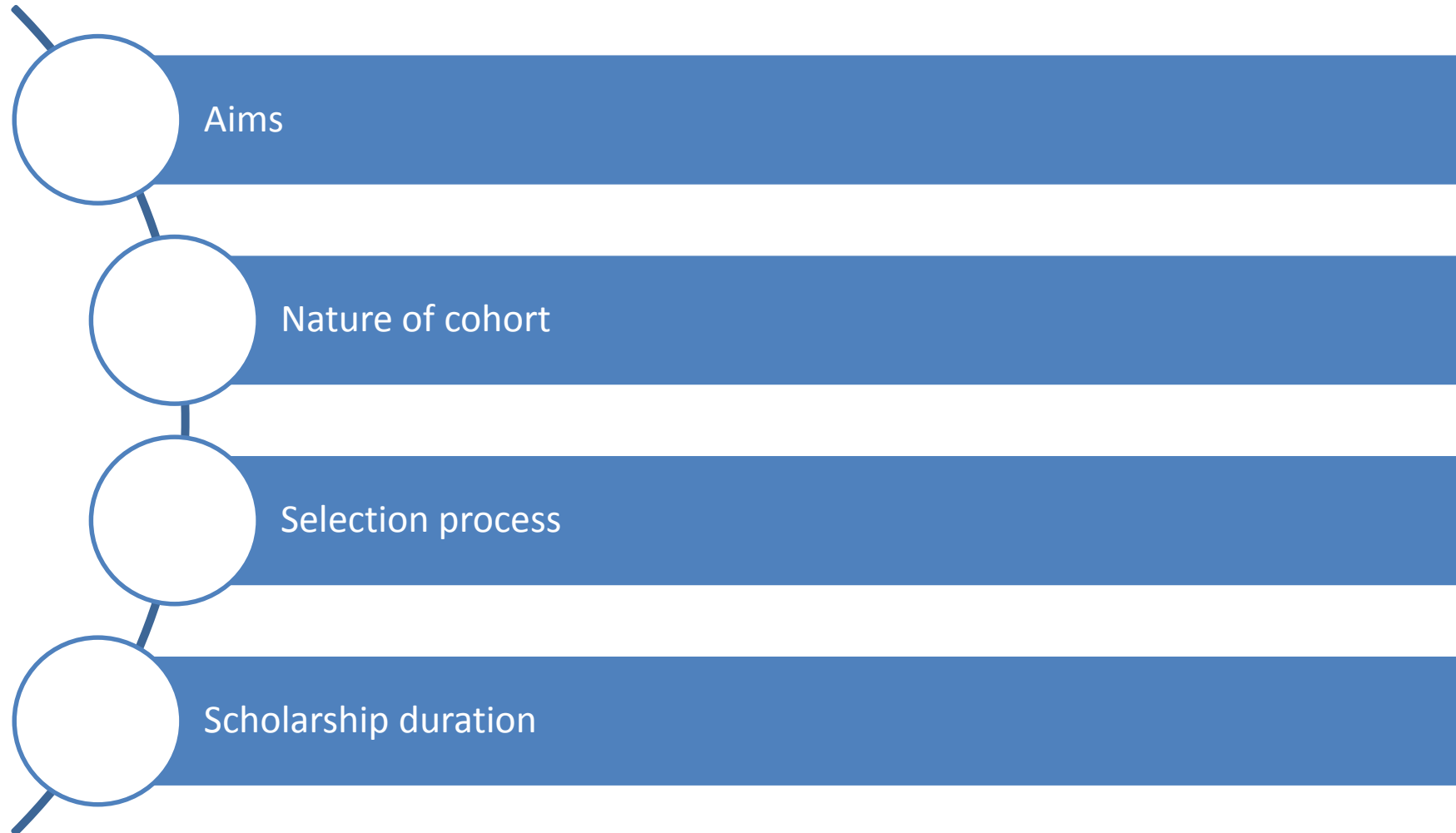

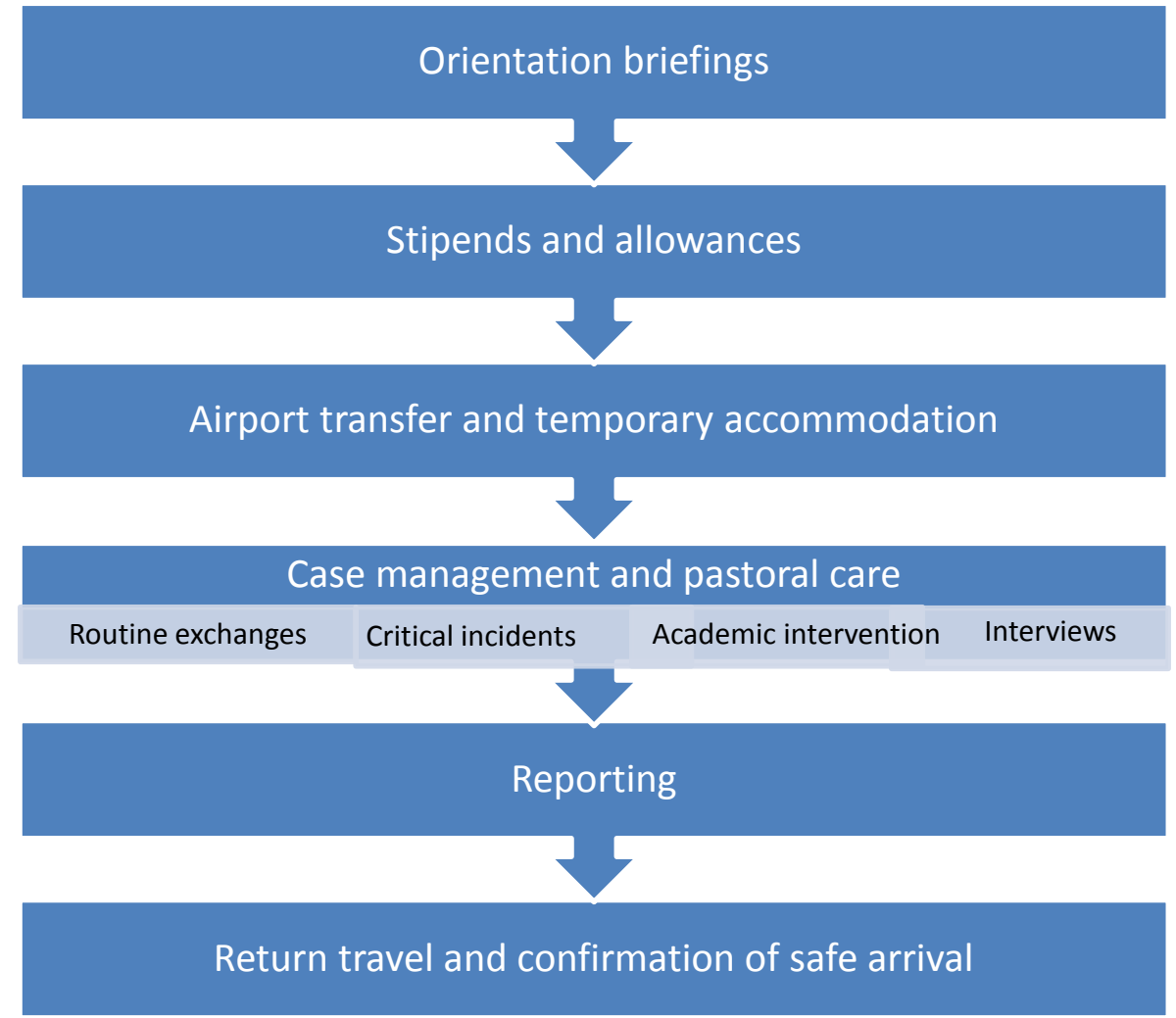
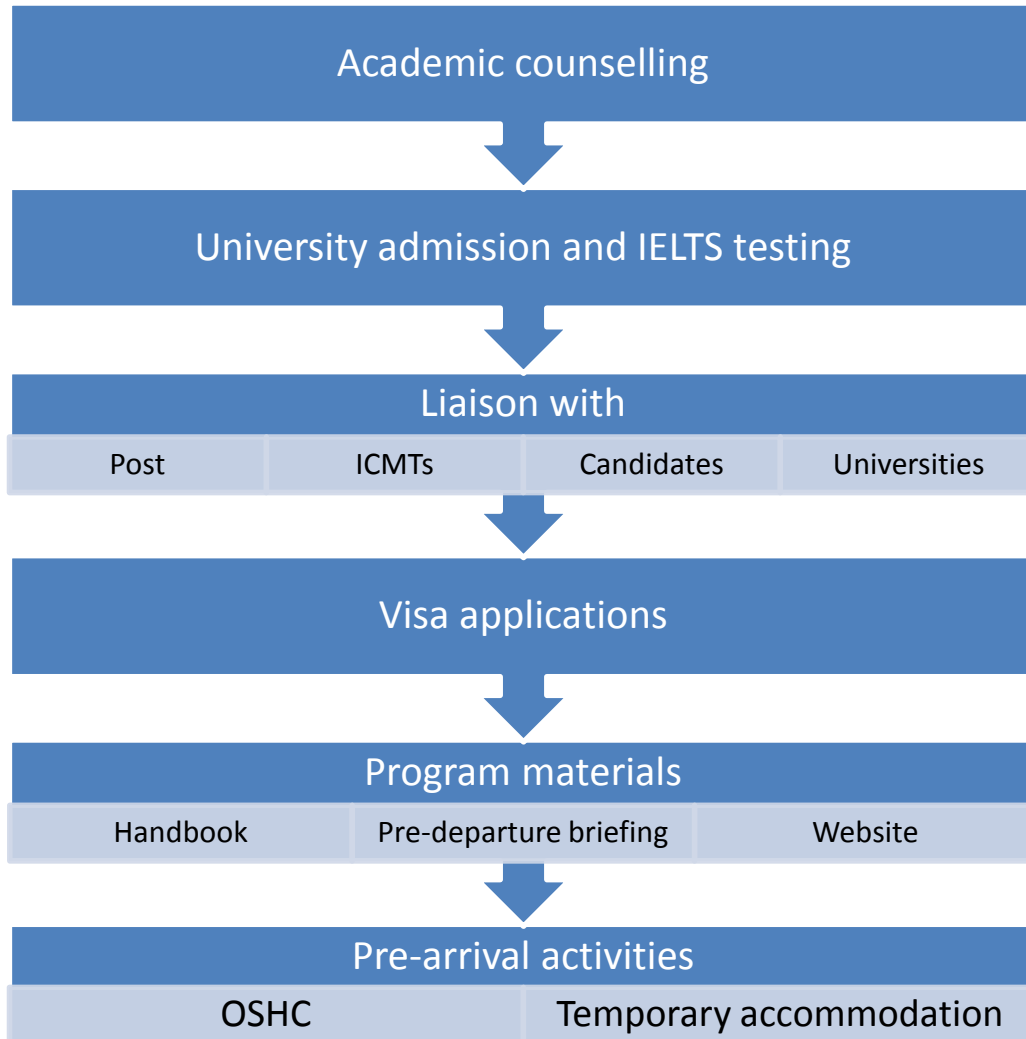

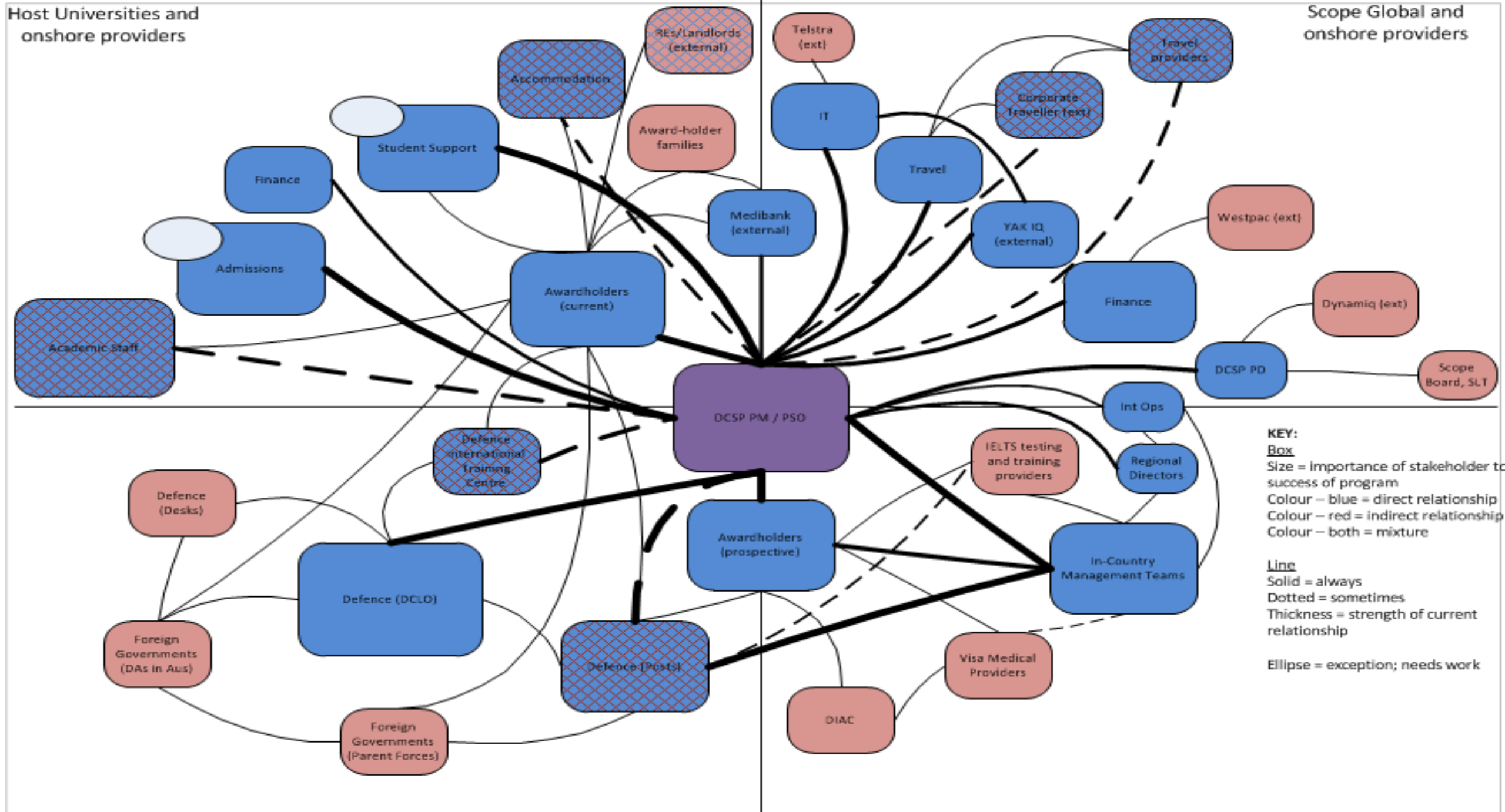


Key stakeholders - overview

 Ellipse = exception; needs work

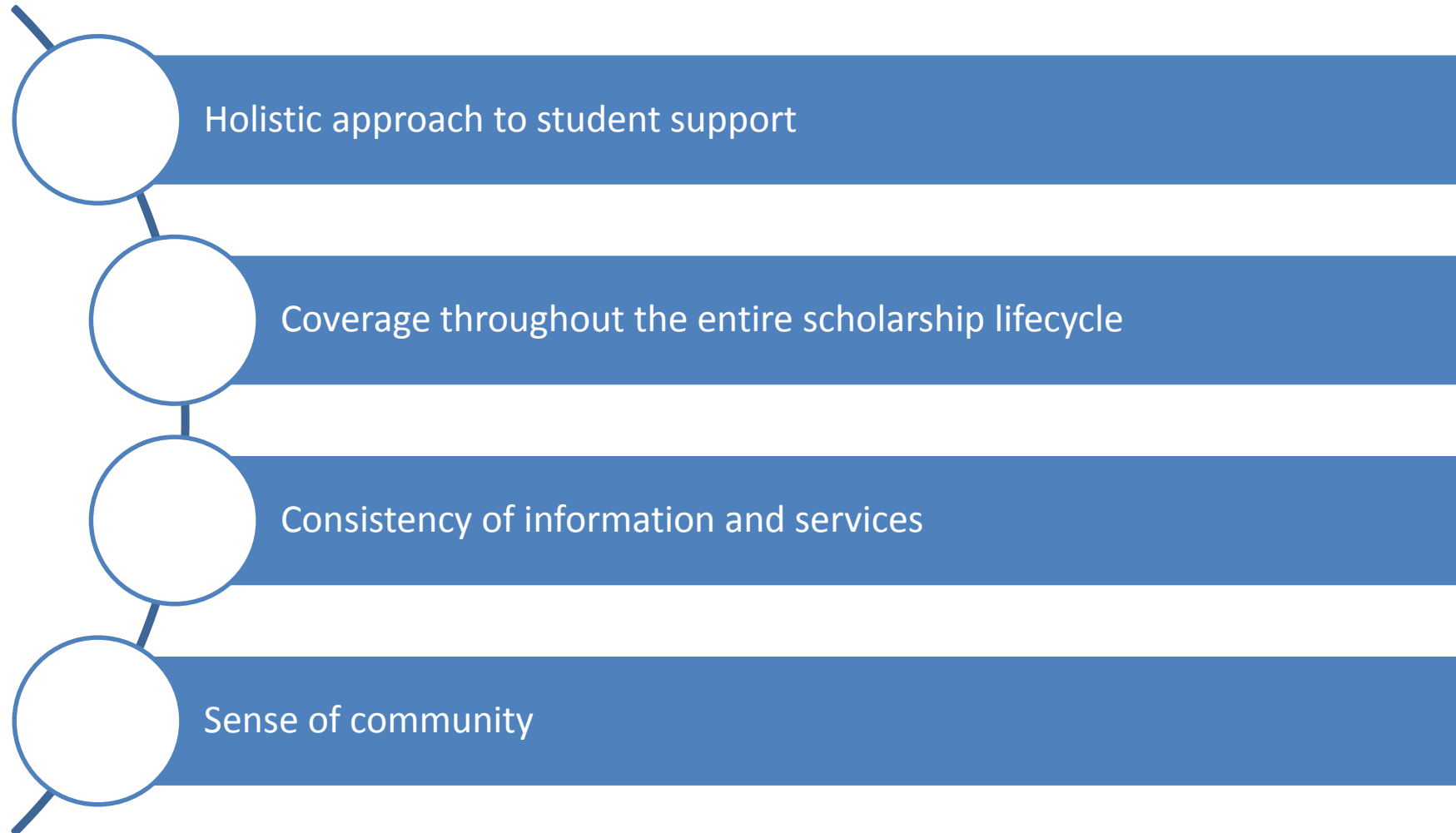
