In this forum, we will seek to explore child safeguarding frameworks and legislation with a lens of supporting culturally appropriate international student support.

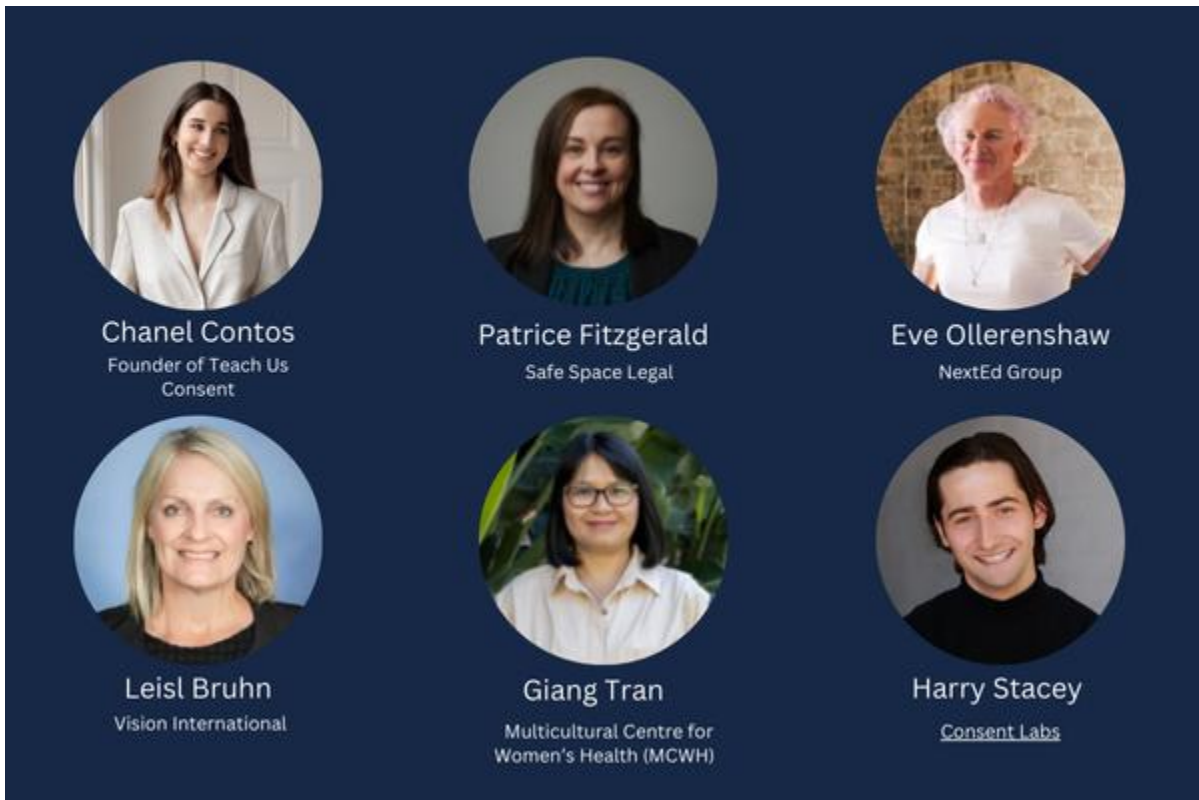
We will focus on impacts of child safeguarding requirements on international education provision and support, taking into account the additional vulnerabilities of international students and students under 18 years of age.
